The **Deacons** will meet **Tuesday, October 8 at 7 PM.** The newly elected deacons should also attend this meeting.



Tuesday, October 8

Come and join us on October 8 at 8 AM as we travel to explore the Campus of Crossnore School and Children's Home located in the town of Crossnore in the Linville Valley of Avery County. Lunch will be



provided at no cost and will be ready by the time we arrive at Crossnore. Hopefully we will see some colorful fall leaves on our way to and from Crossnore. At Crossnore, we will visit the weave room, thrift shop, art gallery, gift shop, a cottage where the children reside and the campus chapel. There will be minimal walking since the bus will be able to drive to each venue. Our hostesses will be Angelina Spencer, Executive Director of Crossnore and Elizabeth O'Hagen, Director of Community Services. Angelina and Elizabeth will ride with us to the various venues. They will provide a history of Crossnore as well as providing current information about the agency. Crossnore will also give each family two books. The first book, "Miracle in the Hills" by Dr. Mary Sloop, tells the story of a woman doctor's forty year crusade to develop a place where mountain children could reside in a safe place and receive an education. The second book, "A Legacy of Caring" by Howard E. Covington, Jr., describes the inspiring story of how Dr. Phyllis H. Crain gave up her career in education to serve as the CEO of Crossnore. Dr. Crain was instrumental in developing Crossnore into one of the premier educational agencies and children's home in the United States. Dr. Crain was from Green Creek in Polk County and was the niece of Betty Bailey. Pat Hunnicutt knew her as well as her parents. Our Volleyball team is off to a great start. Come support our players or jump in the game and help us win! We play at the Spindale House.



WMU RED BOX



POINSETTIAS


