


 **Hey Kids!**

Missionary Union, and various local mission opportunities as
decided by the staff and stewardship committee each quarter
based on the plan selected by each individual. If you would like to
change your plan or select a plan for the first time, please call the
church office. If you have questions about this process, or about
your decision, please feel free to contact one of the staff members.
We try to answer any questions that you may have. If you do not
select a plan, your portion is placed into Plan 5 which includes all
of the agencies listed above.
