Aim for a variety of colors on your plate. Foods like dark, leafy greens, oranges, and tomatoes—even fresh herbs—are loaded with vitamins, fiber, and minerals. **Try this:** Sprinkle fresh herbs over a salad or whole wheat pasta. Make a red sauce using canned tomatoes (look for “low sodium” or “no salt added”), fresh herbs, and spices. Add diced veggies like peppers, broccoli, or onions to stews and omelets to give them a boost of color and nutrients.

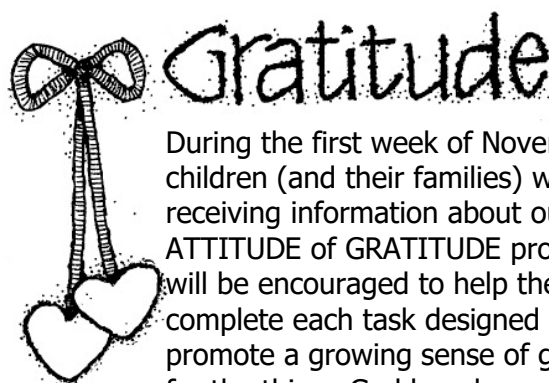
