9AM - 1PM

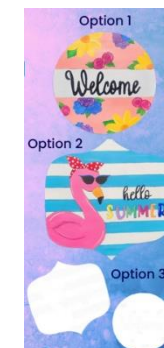
We will stay at the church for this event! After our paint party, we will have an extreme Scavenger Hunt that you don't want to miss!

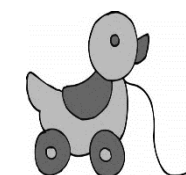
