Reverend M. M. Huntley

Pastor Spotlight

In the coming months, we will be spotlighting the pastors of Spencer Baptist Church. This month will be the Reverend M. M. Huntley. In the Spring of 1926, a group of believers met in the old Spindale Company Store for a worship service. At this service it was suggested that the believers meet again the next Sunday for worship and for the establishment of a Baptist Church. The meeting was held as planned and Spencer Baptist Church was formed on April 25, 1926. Reverend Melrose Maye Huntley was the first pastor. Reverend M. M. Huntley was born May 12, 1878, a son of David and Jane Henson Huntley. He married Ida King on December 28, 1898, they had six children. Reverend Huntley was ordained November 15, 1912, by Adaville Baptist Church. He served as pastor at Mountain View, Adaville, Spindale First, State Line, Lavonia, Trinity, Bethel, Cherokee Creek, Macedonia, Montford Cove, and Spencer, which he helped organized. During his ministry, a Sunday School, a Woman's Missionary Union and a Training Union were organized. Also, the church was given parcels on Oak Street by The Elmore Corporation and Spencer Mills Corporation. The original building was completed in May 1928. The auditorium seated three hundred people. Reverend Huntley served as Pastor at Spencer Baptist from April 25, 1926 through June 24, 1934. Reverend Huntley died January 14, 1937 and is buried in the Huntley Family Cemetery, south of Rutherfordton.



We will have special events on Tuesdays throughout the summer for kids. Registration is **REQUIRED** for all Terrific Tuesday events since most activities require reservations in advance. Our target age for these events is completed Grades 1-5; however, younger kids may participate when accompanied by a parent. Due to VBS and Centrikid, our first Terrific Tuesday will be June 17. A full summer schedule will be available during VBS.



JUNE 17 - Kool Park (day full of swimming): The cost per person is \$12 (under age 12) and \$15 (age 13 and up). Since this is a swimming activity, kids who cannot swim must bring a parent/guardian to supervise. There are plenty of shallow water areas, but we still require parental supervision for non-swimmers. We will leave at 9AM and return around 4:30PM. The registration deadline for Kool Park will be Monday, June 16 at noon.



JUNE 24 – Paint and Play: We will explore our creative side as we paint canvases, create diamond art, and enjoy some old-fashioned play time. The cost for the day is \$5 and we will be at the church from 9AM-12PM. The registration deadline is Monday, June 23 at noon.
