Pastor Spotlight

In the coming months, we will be spotlighting the pastors of Spencer Baptist Church. This month we spotlight Rev. J.A. Brock.

On April 10, 1935, Reverend James Andrew Brock became the second pastor to serve Spencer Baptist Church. Rev. Brock served Spencer Church until May of 1941. Before coming to Spencer, Rev. J. A. Brock served Caroleen Baptist Church in Caroleen. NC from 1929 to 1933. He was born on November 28, 1880 to Andrew B. and Hester Inez Moore Brock in Williamston, South Carolina. Rev. Brock and his wife, Carrie Lela Jennings, had 5 daughters (Agnes Brock, Margaret B. Lee, Annie Brock, Inez Cotin Brock and Martha Elizabeth Brock) and one son (Paul Talmadge Brock, who was the pastor at Shiloh Baptist Church when he retired July 29, 1984). During Rev. Brock's ministry at Spencer, the church saw the need of more auditorium space for the people. Plans were made to enlarge the church and to build a much-needed church parsonage. In 1936, an eight-room parsonage was built on a beautiful location adjacent to the church. Also, during Rev. Brock's ministry, Spencer member Bertie Lee Kendrick dedicated her life to serve in foreign missions, and later was appointed as a missionary by the Foreign Mission Board, now called the International Mission Board. Rev. Brock also served at Beulah Baptist Church in Fountain Inn, SC, and Bethel Baptist Church in Shelby, NC. He was a moderator for Sandy Run Baptist Association. He passed away on January 4, 1963 at the age of 82 in Spartanburg, South Carolina. Rev. J.A. Brock is buried in Sunset Cemetery. Shelby, NC.

<u>Tues, July 15</u> – Gem Mining at Emerald Village! We will discover the beauty found in God's creation as we visit a REAL gem mine. After touring the mine, we will each get a 3Q bucket of gemstone mix to search through for genuine rough gems. The cost is \$15. Bring a picnic lunch. 9AM – 3PM

Tues, July 22 – Nerf Day! We will have all types of Nerf Games for your kids to enjoy. Sign up to join us as we learn how to "Aim for the Target: Following Jesus with all our Might!"
