Rev. W.F. Woodall

This month's pastor spotlight is on Reverend J.C. Canipe and Reverend W.F. Woodall. After Reverend Felix Wagner's resignation on August 19, 1951, Reverend J.C. Canipe became the Supply (Interim) Pastor for Spencer Baptist Church. He served as Pastor until September 16, 1951, at which time the Reverend Max Linen, a student at Gardner Webb, became the Supply Pastor. Reverend W.F. Woodall, having accepted a call of the church, began his pastorate January 6, 1952. Mr. Thomas Westmoreland was secured as Minister of Music in May 1952. He served the church until December 1953. Miss Suthell Walker resigned as Educational Director on November 1, 1953. After a diligent search, a committee recommended Reverend Milton P. Snyder to the church as Minister of Music and Education. Rev. Snyder began serving the church June 11, 1954. During the ministry of Rev. Woodall, the church witnessed extensive growth, both materially and spiritually. Sunday School, Training Union, and Woman's Missionary Union (WMU) were going with full force. The church started sponsoring Boy Scout Troop No. 1. A Social Hall (now the Youth Building) was completed and equipped in 1953 at a cost of \$14,000. In 1954, a Junior and intermediate building was constructed. Upon completion, it had two floors with sixteen rooms per floor and two assembly rooms on each floor. The approximate cost of this building was \$35,000. Construction of a new church steeple was completed in 1955 at a cost of \$2,700. In July 1954, the church debt was abolished and the new auditorium was dedicated on July 11, 1954. Rev. Woodall resigned on May 8, 1960.
