Rev. A.B. Bumgarner

Reverend A. B. Bumgarner became the eighth pastor of Spencer Baptist on November 6, 1960. Prior to his arrival, Spencer called Malone Thomason as Minister of Music (April 1960.) Miss Sarah Perry become education director in 1961 until Miss Marjorie Bridges became the Director of Religious Education in 1964.


In 1964, part of the sanctuary was torn down due to construction of a new education building. On December 9, 1964, the church staff was meeting when suddenly an explosion was heard. The explosion destroyed the remaining part of the old sanctuary. Jake Martin, the church custodian had exited the building just minutes before the explosion. No one was injured.


In May, 1966, Spencer Baptist began to take necessary steps to start a kindergarten. On June 26, 1966 the Kindergarten Committee recommended that Mrs. Malone Thomason (Betty) be elected to serve as the director of the kindergarten and that a fee of \$16 per month, per child, be charged.

During Rev. Bumgarner's ministry, the church celebrated its 50th anniversary on April 11, 1976. The church buildings and property had grown in value in excess of one million dollars since he started his pastorate and one noted major accomplishment was the construction of the \$270,000 educational building in 1965. The church became debt free in 1974, and the budget grew to over \$200,000 with \$70,000 given to missions in 1979.

After touching thousands of lives in Rutherford County and other areas of North Carolina, Rev. A. B. Bumgarner retired on June 22, 1980.



To keep the bathroom available for those who need this type of accommodation, there is a lock on the door with an entry code. The staff will be happy to share this code with any **adults**. If children need to utilize a bathroom with these accommodations, they should be supervised by a parent/quardian.
